

HEALTH RECORDS REQUIRED TO VOLUNTEER

In order to ensure protection of clients, residents and staff, volunteers need to have appropriate vaccination and immunity information on file for Bailey-Boushay House and Virginia Mason Employee Health record keeping.

<u>Please start the process of obtaining the following vaccination or immunization records as soon as possible.</u>

- **Tuberculosis skin testing** (2 PPD's) is required of all volunteers
 - 1. Copies of documentation of X-ray results if previously tested positive.
 - 2. Written documentation from a physician that you had the disease and were treated.
- Measles/Mumps/Rubella (MMR) immunity confirmed by one of the following:
 - 1. Written documentation of two (2) MMR immunizations received after 1968, or
 - 2. Copies of laboratory tests showing immunity, or
 - 3. Born before 1957, or
 - 4. Written documentation from a physician that you had <u>each</u> disease and the date
- **Chickenpox (varicella)** immunity confirmed by one of the following:
 - 1. Written documentation of two (2) varicella vaccinations or
 - 2. Copies of laboratory tests showing immunity.
- **Influenza or Flu vaccination** confirmed by the following:
 - 1. Written documentation of current annual flu vaccination if during flu season
- **Tdap** optional but encouraged
 - 1. Written documentation of most recent vaccination

Records may be obtained from the following sources:

- 1. Childhood vaccination records or school immunization records
- 2. Current place of employment (see Employee Health staff at your current place of work and ask for a summary of your records)
- 3. Physicians office records
- 4. Child Profile (or other online reporting sources)
- 5. Military records
- 6. Travel Vaccination Records
